Day 1: Sunday, October 6, 2013
New Orleans, Louisiana - Tour Begins

Welcome to America's most inviting cultural region. Take some time to acquaint yourself with the city that has given us great music and incredible food: the "Jazz Capital of the World," New Orleans.

Day 2: Monday, October 7, 2013
New Orleans

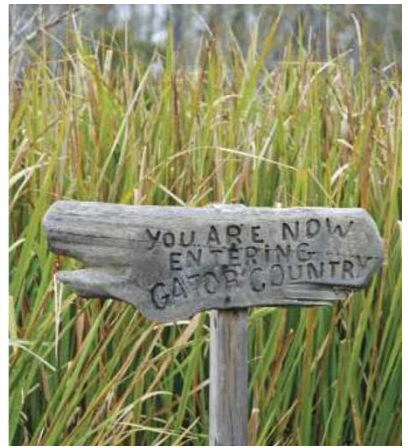
This morning, enjoy a panoramic tour of New Orleans with a local guide. Begin along historic Esplanade Avenue. See St. Louis Cemetery #3 which opened in 1854 and holds some of the most elaborate crypts found in the city's cemeteries. Then, relax during a drive along the shoreline of Lake Pontchartrain. This romantic road eventually leads to St. Charles Avenue, whisking you past gorgeous mansions as well as Tulane and Loyola, two world-famous universities. Return to the French Quartre this afternoon. **Tonight, enjoy an elegant dinner at the Court of Two Sisters, one of New Orleans' most famous restaurants.** (B, D)

Day 3: Tuesday, October 8, 2013
French Quartre

Enjoy a walking tour of the famous French Quartre. Stroll past the majestic St. Louis Cathedral, one of the city's most recognizable landmarks. Continue on to the bustling French Marketplace and explore Pirates Alley, the Cabildo, the Presbytere and the Pontalba. Complete your tour with a stop to taste a true New Orleans favourite - beignets at Café Du Monde. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure to discover the "Big Easy" your way. (B)

Day 4: Wednesday, October 9, 2013
New Orleans - Baton Rouge - Natchez, Mississippi

This morning you travel to Baton Rouge, the capital of Louisiana. Enjoy a guided tour of the Louisiana Province Capitol Building and learn about the province's most influential political figure, Governor Huey Long. Hear the stories and legends from the time of his governorship and witness the location of his untimely assassination at the Province House. Later, continue to Natchez. This small city, resting on a bluff high above the Mississippi River, personifies the grace and elegance of the South with its



preserved antebellum mansions. Tour Stanton Hall, former home of planter and cotton broker Frederick Stanton. This evening you are invited to dinner at Lansdowne House, a privately-owned antebellum plantation home. (B, D)

Day 5: Thursday, October 10, 2013
Natchez

Learn about the rich history of Natchez as a local guide takes you on a captivating tour of this pre-Civil War town. Tour Longwood, an impressive octagonal mansion that today remains unfinished. Construction began shortly before the Civil War and the interior was never completed. Marvel at the beautiful design and imagine the grandeur of what could have been. Experience a taste of the southern lifestyle as you spend the balance of the day at leisure in Natchez. (B)

Day 6: Friday, October 11, 2013
Natchez - Avery Island, Louisiana - Lafayette

Journey to Avery Island, home of the McIlhenny Company's Tabasco Pepper Sauce Factory. Enjoy a guided tour of the factory* and see where this famous sauce is produced and packaged. Later, continue on to Lafayette, the heart of Cajun Country. Visit Martin Accordions, a family-owned accordion shop. Learn about this intricate craft and listen as the

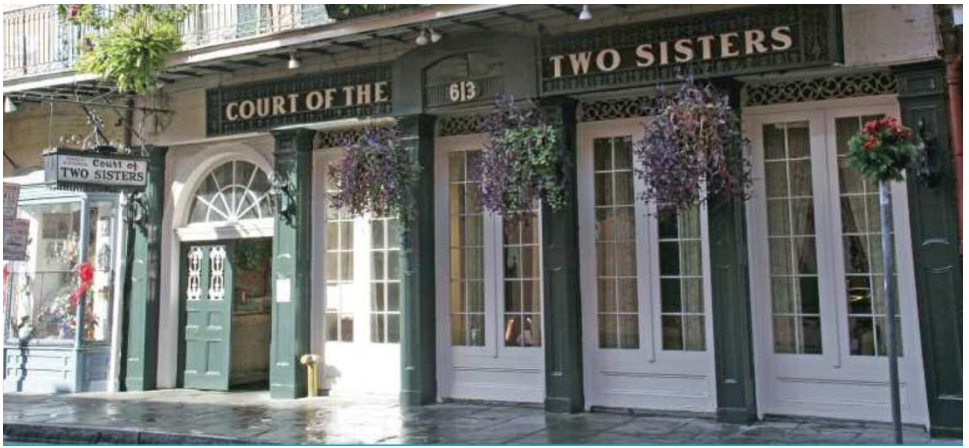
Martin family band entertains you with music and stories. This evening, enjoy dinner at Pont Breaux's Cajun Restaurant, featuring that famous Cajun cooking and live entertainment. (B, D)

Day 7: Saturday, October 12, 2013
Cajun Country

Today, immerse yourself in the Cajun culture. Begin at the Acadian Cultural Centre at Jean Lafitte National Park for an introduction to the history and culture of Cajun Country. Next, visit Vermilionville, a 23-acre living history museum and folklife park showcasing the Cajun and Creole heritages. Later, cruise along the eerie bayous and through the Atchafalaya Basin – no trip to Cajun Country would be complete without seeing the swamp! **This evening, join your fellow travellers for a spectacular farewell dinner and a lesson in Cajun cuisine at the Accidental Chef Cooking School.** Sit back and enjoy the show as the chefs share stories about local life while teaching you the secrets behind some of the delicious regional dishes. (B, D)

Day 8: Sunday, October 13, 2013
Lafayette - New Orleans - Tour Ends

Return to the New Orleans airport and head home with a new appreciation of the South. (B)

This afternoon, enjoy a lunch at a waterfront restaurant. Admire views of the Mississippi River as you dine on local favorites, such as boiled crawfish, shrimp étouffée, or even a po boy sandwich. After lunch, board the paddlewheeler Creole Queen for a relaxing cruise. Pass the French Quarter and the Port of New Orleans while enjoying live narration of the sights and history by the ship's captain. Arrive at Chalmette Battlefield, the site of the Battle of New Orleans that took place during the War of 1812. Learn about General Andrew Jackson's heroic victory over the British forces during a park ranger talk. Spend time exploring the battlefield, National Cemetery and Malus-Beauregard House before your return cruise to New Orleans. *Duration: Approximately 4.5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 15 passengers is required.
